Chonbuk National University(CBNU) was the first national university established in the southern region and has led regional and national development as a global prestigious university. CBNU has 5 campuses and its main campus is located in the most Korean-like city, Jeonju. Chonbuk National University has been ranked 1st in a 2015 evaluation conducted by a national media company as the most fast-developed university in South Korea in the past 20 years. CBNU's performances in education and research, employment and internationalization stand out as well. There are 32,300 students studying in CBNU and it includes about 1,000 international students from 46 countries.



Location

Jeonju, 240km(144miles) south of Seoul, is the capital city of the Jeollabuk-do. The city is known for its history and artistic traditions.

When you arrive at Incheon International Airport, the most convenient way to get to Jeonju is to take the Airport Limousine Bus. It takes 90 minutes from Seoul to Jeonju by KTX train.

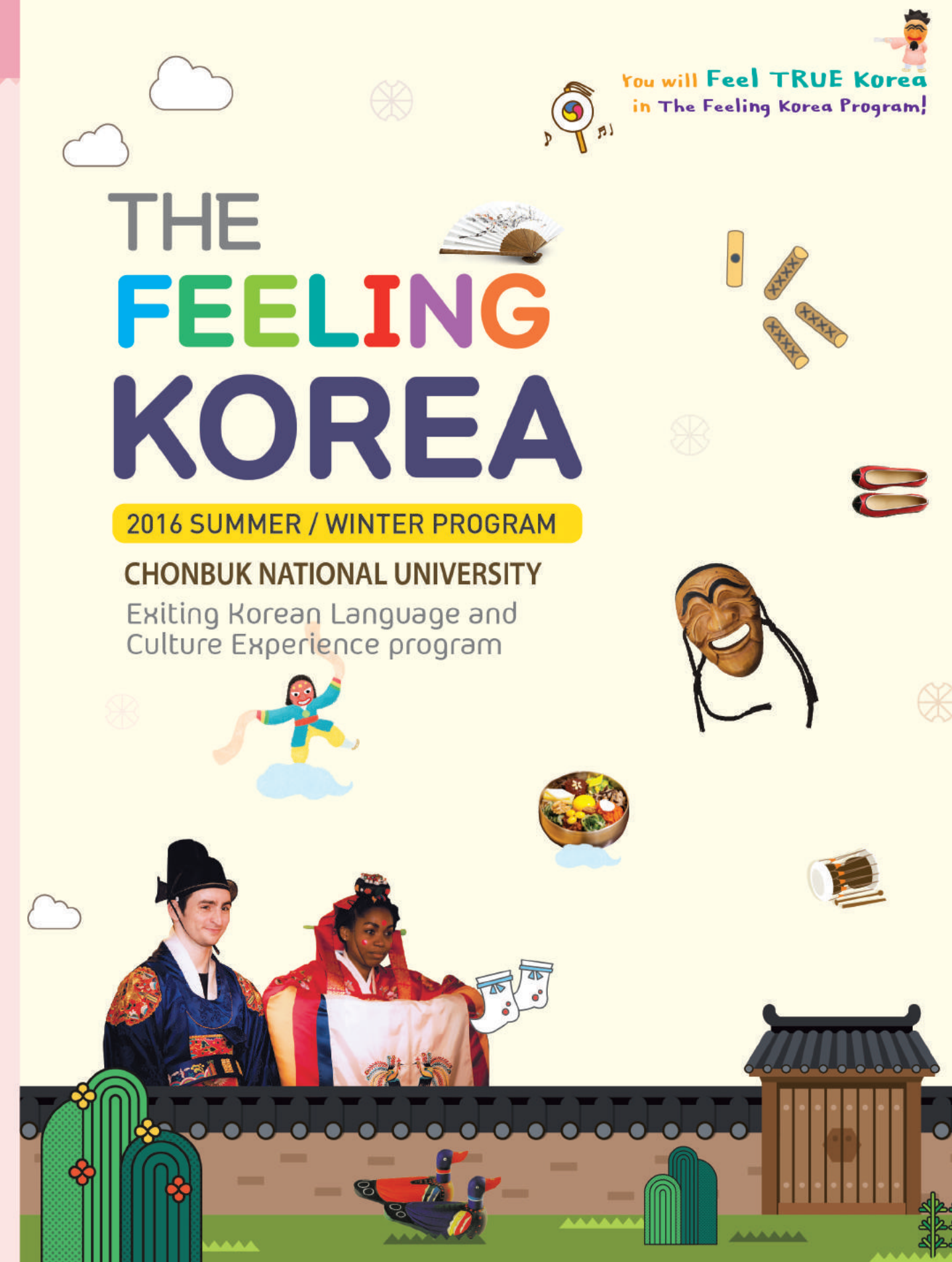
